Scholarship Criteria

This scholarship is extended to all graduating seniors attending an accredited high school in the Cities and Counties of Petersburg, Hopewell, Chesterfield, Prince George, and Dinwiddie. Scholarship amounts may vary and will be determined by the Foundation Board Annually. To be considered for a Scholarship, the student **MUST** be accepted as a full-time freshman for the fall school term for 2024 at an accredited college or university. The scholarship will be based on individual financial need, academic achievement, extracurricular activities and participation in community service.

To apply for the scholarship, the student must:

- ✓ Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5.
- ✓ Submit a completed application.
- ✓ Submit an official transcript indicating overall GPA and class rank. Transcripts must include all grades through the first semester of student's senior year.
- Submit two (2) <u>original</u> letters of recommendation. The first must be from an educator who can attest to academic knowledge of you as a student. The second letter may be from an employer, community leader, minister, or someone other than a family member who can attest to your character and significant community achievements. The person making the recommendation must submit all letters to the foundation in a sealed envelope with their name written on the seal.
- ✓ Submit a color camera ready wallet size *photo* (To be placed on the program if you are selected as a scholarship winner)
- ✓ Submit a biographical essay, not to exceed 250 words. This essay must include information about you and your family, your educational career goals, and your plans to achieve these goals.
- ✓ Submit copies of letters of acceptance from your college or university.
